Language requirement	<p>Depending on the language of instruction, international students are required to have an advance level – B2, to be able to successfully complete courses at FTHM. FTHM does not require official language certificate but we trust our partners to send us students who fulfil the aforementioned criteria. If the students do not meet the language requirement faculty reserves the right to withdraw them from the courses and program.</p> <p>Depending on the language of lectures, teachers are required to have an advance level</p>



	<p>of English or Croatian – C1, to be able to successfully teach courses at FTHM. Administrative staff involved in the mobility program should have an advance level – B1 of English.</p>
Course Information	<p>We offer English courses from exchange students at undergraduate and graduate level in a field of business administration, economics and tourism. Students with the advance language of Croatian can enrol in a vast number of courses offered to Croatian students (special request required). Student can enrol classes at both level of study (undergraduate and graduate) if the host university confirms the enrolment of the class.</p> <p>Academic calendar: Winter semester (first): beginning of October – end of January Summer semester (second): beginning of March – end of June Examination period: February, end of June, beginning of July https://www.fthm.uniri.hr/index.php/ia-courses-calendar</p> <p>Welcome day for incoming students (mandatory): first day of classes in a semester https://www.fthm.uniri.hr/index.php/ia-courses-class</p> <p>List and syllabus of courses: https://www.fthm.uniri.hr/index.php/courses/ia-courses-list Note: the final list of offered courses for the new academic year is available online end May in current academic year</p> <p>Class Format and registration: Courses have a continuous assessment of student performance and they include lectures, presentations, papers etc. Class attendance is mandatory. There is no special registration for the classes. The registration is done automatically after the Learning Agreement is signed by the FTHM coordinator. When choosing the courses student must take in account the level of study. It is possible that some courses overlap but that is very rear.</p> <p>Courses Load: Normal courses load for one semester normal is 30 ECTS. For students that are staying for a whole year normal load is 60 ECTS. There courses load for incoming students depends on the mobility and scholarship program.</p> <p>Grading system: Grading system for courses on the undergraduate and graduate level differ. Details on the activities percentage scores differ from course to course. The course coordinator will inform the students about the grading system during the first lecture in the class. https://www.fthm.uniri.hr/index.php/courses/ia-courses-list</p> <p>Transcript of Record: We will issue a report for each student at the end of semester in February/July. The report will be send to the student e-mail and to coordinator at home institution (if required).</p> <p>Confirmation of Stay: Please note that a confirmation of stay will only be issued for the period of actual studies at FTHM. The welcome day will be declared as their date of arrival. The last day</p>



	<p>that can be confirmed on the confirmation of stay is the last day That student need to be present at FTHM (e.g. last day of classes, last exam). Exam dates depend on the course chosen.</p>
